

LAKE AVENUE PEDESTRIAN ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Project Description

- This project provides streetscape improvements to enhance pedestrian access and circulation along a 1.06-mile segment of Lake Avenue, from the Gold Line Station at Corson Street south to California Boulevard. The addition of pedestrian lighting, controlled mid-block street crossing and accessibility improvements at new and existing signalized intersections will enhance the overall pedestrian experience through this busy commercial corridor.

Project Improvements

- New traffic signal at Granite Drive
- Signalized mid-block crossing south of Cordova
- In-fill pedestrian scale lighting
- Curb extensions and ADA compliant curb ramps
- Sidewalk widening on Lake north of Colorado

Current Project Schedule

- Street lighting poles and luminaires installed. Wiring underway with anticipated completion in April 2024.
- Preparing for traffic signal foundations.
- Civil construction work at Union underway moving southerly towards Granite intersection.



Project Status (4/3/2024)

Street lighting 90% completed, traffic signal construction 50%, beginning civil streetscape improvements currently at Union Street moving southerly with work at Colorado, mid-block between Cordova and Del Mar, Del Mar intersection and finally at Granite intersection. Anticipated construction completion in July 2024.
